Free Craft Project Tutorial-Open Top Nail Varnish Box

Make your own gift box that holds a square shared nail varnish. If you wish to purchase any of the products used in today's project please go to: www.smithscraftycreations.stampinup.net

Materials Required

- 1. Cardstock
- Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- 3. Trimmer and Scoring Tool
- 4. Stamp Set and Ink
- 5. Scissors, Adhesives and Glue Dots
- 6. Embellishments, Ribbon, Die cut extras for decoration

Finished Dimensions of Box $1" \times 1" \times 3"$

Measurements

Step 1—Cut a piece of Cardstock down to 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

♥Scoring♥ (if using DSP don't score too hard!)

Step 2—Shortest side to top of score board: Score at 1", 2", 3" and 4" Turn so that long side to top: Score at 1", 4" and 5" Fold and burnish.

Cutting

Step 3—With glue flap to right side, Cut away two smallest rectangles at top and one at bottom. Cut up four short score-lines at bottom. Cut little wedges out, this is the bottom of the box. On the opposite end cut up the three score lines to the second horizontal score line. Cut away the first tab and punch out half circle. Cut half of the second and fourth flap. The remaining third tab is the fold over lid. See photo above.

🎔 Layers 🎔

Step 4—If you want to layer your box with an 1/8" increment you will need: A) x4 at 7/8" x 2-7/8" B) x2 at 7/8" x 7/8"

🎔 Stamping & Decoration 🎔

Step 5— Decorate as you wish.

Step 6— Add your bottle inside and close box

Tip: Add an acetate window by punching / die cutting a section away from the first box panel.
