

Free Craft Project Tutorial—Diamond Front Card

Measurements:

- 1 piece of 6x6 cardstock for base
- 1 piece of 5.3/4" x 5.3/4" for matt layer
- 1 piece of 5.1/2" x 5.1/2" patterned paper for top layer
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- 1 piece of 5.3/4" x 5.3/4 neutral cardstock for back of card
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- OR one piece of Window Sheet Acetate 6.1/2" x 1/2"
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- 1 piece of 4.3/8" x 4.3/8" for the front diamond panel base
- 1 piece of 4.1/8" x 4.1/8" for the matt layer
- 1 piece of 3.78" x 3.7/8" for the patterned paper layer on top
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- 1 piece of 4.1/4" x 2" for the sentiment panel
- 1 piece of 4" x 1.3/4" for matt layer
- 1 piece of 3.3/4" x 1.1/2" for stamping layer

Instructions:

1. Score along the 6.1/2" side of acetate at 1/2" fold and burnish
2. Adhere this to the 6" x 6" in the middle to form the front of card
3. Adhere your next two matts to card base
4. Matt and layer your diamond section and adhere to acetate strip panel (use tear n tape or Stampin' Seal)
5. Layer up the centre rectangle panel and stamp your sentiment
6. Adhere to the centre of the diamond front
7. Adhere your neutral 5.3/4" x 5.3/4" piece to rear of card (you need somewhere to write your
