

# Free Craft Project Tutorial— Double Tea Bag Holder

Make your own gift pouch that holds two tea bags. If you wish to purchase any of the products used in today's project please go to: www.smithscraftycreations.stampinup.net

## **Materials Required**

- 1. Two Individually wrapped teabags
- 2. Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- Trimmer and Scoring Tool
- 4. Stamp Set and Ink
- 5. Scissors, Adhesives and Glue Dots
- 6. Ribbon and embellishments if you wish to decorate further

## Finished Dimensions of Pouch 3" x 3"

### Measurements >

Step 1—Cut a piece of DSP or Cardstock down to 6" x 6" or use a sheet from a 6x6 pack.

♥Scoring♥ (if using DSP don't score too hard!)

Second Step —Score at 1.1/2" and 4.1/2" on one side. Turn once and score at 3". Fold and burnish.



#### Folding

Step 3—Fold in half along 3" score line. Bring each side up and create triangle fold. Bend one forward and one to the back (see YouTube Tutorial)

#### **₩** Adherina

Step 4—Adhere tear and tape to bottom of both sides to adhere down the folds.

## 🎔 Stamping & Decoration 🎔

Step 5— Stamp and fussy cut your chosen sentiment. Decorate your pouch and add sentiment last.

## Closure and Contents

Step 5—Add your teabags then package in cello bag.
