

Free Craft Project Tutorial—Tuck Flap Pencil Box

Make your own gift box that holds three standard sized pencils. If you wish to purchase any of the products used in today's project please go to: www.smithscraftycreations.stampinup.net



Instructions:

Materials Required

- 1. Cardstock
- 2. Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- 3. Trimmer and Scoring Tool
- 4. Stamp Set and Ink
- 5. Scissors, Adhesives and Glue Dots
- 6. Embellishments, Ribbon, Die cut extras for decoration

Finished Dimensions of Box $7-3/8" \times 1" \times 3/8"$

- Measurements
 Step 1—Cut a piece of DSP or Cardstock down to 8-5/8" x 3"
- (if using DSP don't score too hard!)

Second Step —Long side to top of score board: Score at 3/8", 3/4" and 8-1/4" Turn so that short side to top: Score at 1", 1-3/8", 2-3/8" and 2-3/4" Fold and burnish.

Cutting

Step 3—With glue flap to right side, cut away as per image overleaf.

Step 4—If you want to layer your box with an 1/8" increment you will need: A) x2 at 7-3/8" x 7/8" B) x2 7-3/8" x 1/4" C) x2 7/8" x 1/4"

Stamping & Decoration

Step 5— Stamp and fussy cut your chosen sentiment. Decorate your box and add sentiment last.

♥ Closure and Contents ♥ Step 6—Add your treat / gift then close (adding label on ribbon if you wish).
